6. Describe the contribution the artist made in the world of art. (i.e. Did they inspire others to mimic them? Did they create a new style of artwork?)

7. Find at least 2 samples of their artwork online and include them in your presentation.

8. Sources: Record all of the websites and books you used during your research. Remember to document all sources (websites and books) in the required form.

9. Create a piece of art that mimics the work of your artist.
